- 2. <u>Beyond the Polar Code: Assuring Safe and Environmentally Sound Arctic Navigation</u> navigation aids & nautical charts; ship-routing measures; search & rescue; security; marine insurance; ports & repair facilities; places of refuge; non-SOLAS ships
- 3. <u>Arctic Governance</u> geopolitical implications of a 'new' Arctic; Arctic Council; Stakeholder interests, rights & participation (Indigenous peoples, coastal communities, non-Arctic states, WMO, IHO)
- Sustainable Arctic Business Development

Immediately after the abstract, please provide at least 4 to 6 keywords. The abstracts should be submitted by 30 June 2015. Submissions will be evaluated for their quality and relevance to the Conference. Authors will be notified of their acceptance.
