Our Ocean 2019, Oslo 23-24 October

The Our Ocean conference has been held annually since 2014, when the first conference was hosted by then US Secretary of State, John Kerry. The conference brings together leaders from governments, business, civil society and research institutions. The aim is to trigger, amplify and accelerate action for clean, healthy and productive oceans. There is no negotiated document from the conference. Instead, the main outcome is in the form of voluntary commitments under the following six areas of action: marine protected areas, climate change, sustainable fisheries, marine pollution, sustainable blue economy, and maritime security.

Previous conferences have resulted in nearly one thousand commitments. At this year's conference, participants are encouraged to announce new and far-reaching commitments to the best of our oceans.
